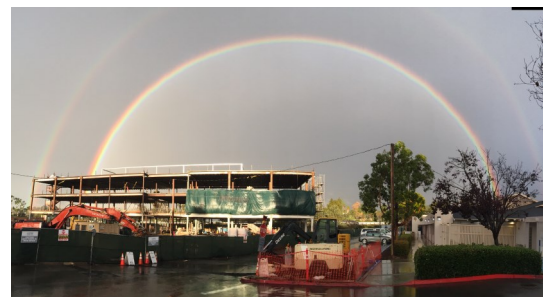

Hooked on Robotics: the new Robotic Navigational Bronchoscopy

Scripps Encinitas is already recognized as a regional center for excellence in interventional pulmonology and diagnostic lung cancer care. Lung cancer is the world's leading cause of cancer deaths. With technology that was unimaginable a few years ago, the **robotic navigational bronchoscopy** will improve the detection and treatment of lung disease in patients. Dr. Samir Makani and the pulmonary team will utilize this cutting-edge technology, along with the BodyTom CT scanner, to evaluate even the smallest lesions within the lung and eventually, provide treatment to detected lung cancers.
