CONSTRUCTION, NOW UNDERWAY!

To facilitate streamlined care for our patients, Scripps will be expanding Scripps MD Anderson Cancer Center at Torrey Pines and will be building a new location, Prebys Cancer Center at Scripps Mercy Hospital. Multidisciplinary clinics will be located in these centers, as well as on the Scripps Encinitas and Scripps La Jolla campuses.



Scripps MD Anderson Cancer Center, Torrey Pines

Scripps Radiation Therapy Center, located on the Torrey Pines Mesa, was built in 2012, with expansion in mind. The facility will expand 16,500 square feet to encompass the multidisciplinary clinic for newly diagnosed cancer patients. Construction will begin fall 2019 and will be completed in 2020.



Prebys Cancer Center, Scripps Mercy Hospital

In August 2019, we will begin construction on Prebys Cancer Center at Scripps Mercy Hospital, a new four-story 40,000 square foot cancer center. The comprehensive cancer center will open in 2022 and will include multidisciplinary clinics, physician collaboration spaces, radiation therapy, and an infusion suite with floor-to-ceiling windows, with views and access to the center's two healing gardens.


Barbara and Arlo Trieglaff

SCRIPPS MD ANDERSON OPENS CLINIC FOR RARE, AGGRESSIVE BREAST CANCER



Scripps MD Anderson Cancer Center recently launched San Diego County's first dedicated clinic for patients who have inflammatory breast cancer (IBC), a rare and aggressive form of the disease.

"IBC differs greatly from other forms of breast cancer in a number of ways, so it requires a dedicated approach that focuses on a unique set of challenges," said Dr. Thomas Buchholz, medical director of Scripps MD Anderson and a lead physician in its IBC clinic. "It's often hard to diagnose and it can spread fast, so it's critical that patients receive prompt treatment from experienced specialists working together as an integrated team."

Doctors involved in the Scripps MD Anderson IBC Clinic have specialized training and clinical experience in diagnosing and treating the disease. The clinic is integrated and collaborates with the IBC clinic at MD Anderson, in Houston. The Scripps MD Anderson IBC physician team will have the opportunity to review cases with colleagues in Houston.
